



THERE WERE PLANS TO BUILD A HOSPITAL AT THE LOCATION, BUT BECAUSE OF THE GRAVES THEY COULD NOT REALISE THE PLAN.

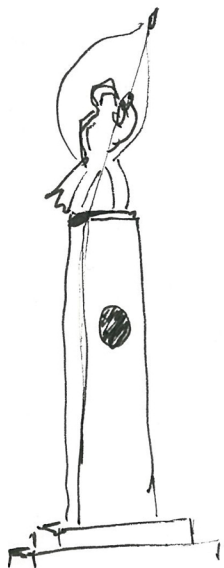
OBELISK WITH THE TEXT "SLAVA TO SOVIET HEROES 1944" WAS ERECTED AT GARDEN OF POADOR'S HOUSE. IT COMMEMORATED THE 77 SOVIET SOLDIERS BURIED THERE. THE HOUSE HAD SERVED AS HOSPITAL DURING WWII.

POADOR'S HOUSE WAS TURNED INTO HEADQUARTERS OF MUSEUM OF ROMANIAN LITERATURE (MLRI) AS PROPOSED BY LOCAL COMMUNIST INTELLECTUALS.

EVERY 7TH OF NOVEMBER PEOPLE FROM THE RUSSIAN EMBASSY CAME TO PUT FLOWERS AT THE MEMORIAL.

DIRECTOR OF MLRI AT THE TIME, LUCIAN VASILIU REQUESTED MOVING OF THE GRAVES AS HE WAS ANNOYED BY SUCH ANESTHETIC AND VICINITY.

GRAVES IN GARDEN OF POADOR'S HOUSE WERE EXHUMED AND REBURIED AT ETERNITATE CEMETERY. THE OBELISK DISAPPEARED. IT WAS SECRETLY BURIED IN POADOR'S GARDEN. OR IT WAS ALSO TAKEN TO ETERNITATE AND IS NOW USED AS SOCLE FOR THE MARBLE CROSS.



8 METERS TALL MONUMENT OF BRONZE WAS ERECTED AT COPOU HILL. BORIS CARAGEA WAS THE ARTIST WHO MADE IT. OR CONSTANTIN BARASCHI. IT COMMEMORATED THE BREAKING OF THE FRONTLINE IN COPOU ON 21. AUGUST 1944, WITH TEXT: "SLAVA TO THE HEROES AND THE GLORIOUS SOVIET ARMY FALLEN IN BATTLE FOR THE LIBERATION OF ROMANIA FROM FASCISM."

SOME STUDENTS OF HISTORY VANDALISED THE STATUE WITH GRAFFITI AND PROTESTED CEREMONY OF RUSSIAN OFFICIALS.

IASI CITY HALL & SIMIRAT GAVE THE REMAINS OF THE STATUE TO WAR VETERANS' ASSOCIATION IASI BRANCH.

AMBASSADOR OF RUSSIA TO ROMANIA COMPLAINED ABOUT DISAPPEARANCE OF THE STATUE.

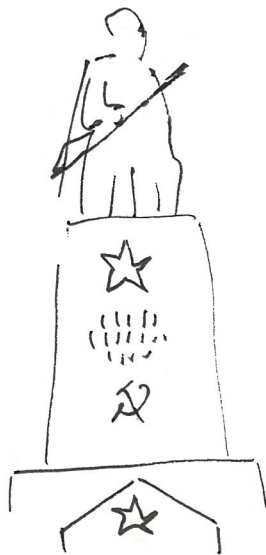
MONUMENT WAS MOVED TO ETERNITATE CEMETERY AND PLACED ON THE SAME BASE WHERE THE STONE MONUMENT HAD EARLIER STOOD.

STATUE WAS REMOVED. SIMIRAT WAS MAYOR AT THE TIME AND FLORIN KINTIK, NOW HEAD OF NATIONAL ARCHIVES WAS HEAD OF CULTURAL DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY.

THE STATUE WAS MELTED AND RE-USED FOR MICHAEL THE BRAVE. OR IT WAS USED FOR THE HORSE OF THE STATUE. OR IT WAS SOLD TO SOMEONE IN RUSSIA.

RUSSIAN EMBASSY IS PUTTING EXTREMELY HARD PRESSURE ON THE IASI CITY HALL TO HAVE THE DISAPPEARED MONUMENT REPLACED. THEY APPEAL ON AN INTERNATIONAL LAW ABOUT PROTECTION OF ALL WWII MONUMENTS, AND DESTROYED ONES HAVE TO BE REPLACED.

AN ARCHITECT TOOK THE STAR FROM THE STATUE AND DONATED IT TO MUSEUM OF HISTORY AT PALACE OF CULTURE. IT ALSO DISAPPEARED.



MONUMENT OF STONE, OR PERHAPS CEMENT DEPICTING A SOVIET SOLDIER WAS ERECTED AT ETERNITATE CEMETERY BY THE CITY HALL. TEXT IN IT SAID: "SLAVA TO SOVIET HEROES 1944" IT COMMEMORATED THE 133 SOVIET SOLDIERS BURIED AT ETERNITATE CEMETERY.

MONUMENT DISAPPEARED

MARBLE CROSS WAS ERECTED WHERE THE ANTI-FASCIST MONUMENT HAD BEEN.

GRAVE STONES WERE REPAINTED
